- HOA paid \$9k to remove falling trees along Gillespie. Plan is to replace damaged fence line. This was an unanticipated expense for the year. We have removed over a dozen trees this year. Need neighbors assistance to watch for other leaning trees and report to HOA Board for removal. Always need volunteers for removal help.
- The HOA will explore options with Madison City regarding flooding issues on Preserve grounds between Walden Glen Court and Walden Glen Road.
