HOA President's Corner

Dear Walden Homeowners and Residents,

I am delighted to be your HOA President this year. Having moved to this neighborhood a few years ago and working on previous years' boards, I want to continue to see our community remain the golden standard for the City of Madison. I am grateful this year to be joined by Melanie O'Neill and Andrea Green, our returning Secretary and Treasurer, respectively, and who both bring a great wealth of knowledge and experience. I am also grateful to be joined by Rod Ashcraft and Jim Ross serving as vice presidents. Rod has previously served on the board in multiple positions and brings great experience; while Jim is new to our board, he has no lack of experience.

Our objectives this year are to maintain the community property and enforce community standards. We began the process of repairing the clubhouse by tendering quotes for window replacement which we will complete this year. We are also preparing to replace the air conditioning unit at the clubhouse which is 15 years old. To save money, we are looking for storage solutions to reduce or eliminate the need for annual rental of a self-storage unit.

As our first official act this year as a board, we voted to increase annual dues by \$70 per year. This is the first HOA dues increase ever for our neighborhood. We felt it was important due not only to our increased annual operating costs, but also to support major repairs throughout our community. Overdue repairs such as these, paying for repairs due to vandalism, and removing dead or dying trees endangering property quickly eliminated our surplus last year and we are expecting similar maintenance costs over the next few years.

I look forward to hearing from the homeowners and residents at our upcoming HOA Board meetings. We need your input to keep our community safe and to help refine our priorities.

<u>Other News</u>: We recently emptied the storage unit on Balch Road due to another price increase. Rather than pay \$960/year to store old records and holiday decorations, we are seeking estimates to enclose the side patio of the clubhouse. For now, HOA board members are storing these items in their homes.

Covid isn't gone yet. We have opened the clubhouse for rental and will open the pool soon, but they are both used at your own risk.

Spring is in the air and we are enjoying our time outside! Here's a friendly reminder to please keep dogs on leashes while walking them, and please clean up after your pet. No one wants a surprise in their yard. Keep Walden beautiful.
