## Walden Fence Specifications

With the exception of Property that abuts the Conservancy Areas, all fences in Walden should be constructed and maintained to the following specifications:

- Wood fences should be 6-foot shadowbox construction with 4 " $\times 4$ " Gothic posts and convex scallops. Fences must be stained with opaque dark brown stain.
- Corner posts should be nominal 19" square structures, constructed of brick to coordinate with the house. A band detail should be included at a height of 6 feet and the structure should be capped with a final course of brick.
- Fence posts should be maintained plumb and in good repair. Warped or rotten pickets should be replaced, and stain should be refreshed, as needed, in order to keep a tidy appearance.

While there are no "approved" colors for the fence stain, examples include:

- Valspar Dark Mahogany
- Behr Coffee (DR-358)
- Behr Oxford Brown (DP-359)
- Behr Padre Brown (DP-355)

In order to avoid obstructing views of the natural areas, owners with property lines that abut the Conservancy Areas may elect to install a black wrought iron fence or similarly styled black aluminum fence in lieu of the shadowbox fence. Note: Not all wooded areas are owned by the Walden HOA and are subject to future development.
